The INSTRIDE 4 Study is looking to see how well an investigational insulin works to control blood sugar levels when taken in addition to an FDA-approved, rapid-acting insulin at mealtimes. Participants will receive the study medications at no charge for the duration of the study. By taking part in this study, you could be part of making Type 1 Diabetes treatment more affordable worldwide.

You may be able to take part in the INSTRIDE 4 Study if you:

- are between 18 and 65 years of age
- have been diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes
- have been taking Lantus® (insulin glargine) for at least 3 months
- have not used animal insulin in the past 3 years.
